

**NOTICE REGARDING INITIAL DETERMINATION ON VIOLATION OF SECTION
337 AND RECOMMENDED DETERMINATION ON REMEDY AND BONDING**

(December 16, 2015)

On this date, the ALJ issued an initial determination on violation of Section 337 and recommended determination on remedy and bond in the above-referenced investigation. It is held that a violation of section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, 19 U.S.C. § 1337, has occurred in the importation into the United States, the sale for importation, or the sale within the United States after importation of certain three-dimensional cinema systems and components thereof by reason of infringement of the asserted claims of U.S. Patent No. 7,857,455, U.S. Patent No. 7,959,296, and U.S. Patent No. 8,220,934.
