337 AND RECOMMENDED DETERMINATION ON REMEDY AND BOND**



On this date, the undersigned issued an Initial Determination on violation of Section 337 and a recommended determination on remedy and bond, and the public interest in the above-referenced investigation.

It is held that a violation of Section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, has been found in the importation into the United States, the sale for importation, or the sale within the United States after importation, of certain network devices, related software, and components thereof, by reason of infringement of United States Patent Nos. 6,377,577 and 7,224,668.
