

ORDER NO. 2: INITIAL DETERMINATION SETTING A SIXTEEN AND A HALF (16.5)-MONTH TARGET DATE

Pursuant to Commission Rule 210.51(a), a target date for completion of the Investigation in the above-captioned matter must be set. The Notice of Investigation was published on September 6, 2017. 82 Fed. Reg. 42116 (Sept. 6, 2017). Given this Court's schedule in Inv. No. 337-TA-1064, for which the final initial determination on violation ("ID") is due on August 7, 2018, as well responsibilities in other investigations, a 16.5-month target date is set for this Investigation. Accordingly, the target date for this Investigation will be January 21, 2019, and the final ID will be due September 20, 2018.


