

Respondents Intel Corporation; Intel Americas, Inc.; Componentes Intel de Costa Rica S.A.; Intel Technology Sdn. Bhd; Intel Products (Chengdu) Ltd., Inc.; Apple Inc.; and Hewlett-Packard Company (collectively, "Respondents") moved to amend the procedural schedule governing the hearing dates and post-hearing submissions in this investigation. Motion Docket No. 781-50. Complainant X2Y Attenuators, LLC ("X2Y") filed an opposition to the motion, and the Commission investigative staff indicated that it does not oppose the motion. Mot. at 2.

Respondents seek to move the hearing in this investigation from August 20-24, 2012 to August 27-31, 2012 in order to accommodate the schedule of its lead trial counsel. Mot. at 1-2. X2Y argues that two of its expert witnesses have conflicts with Respondents' proposed schedule, and that rescheduling the hearing would result in prejudice to X2Y and its experts. Opp'n at 1.

The undersigned has a hearing scheduled for September 5-11, 2012 in another investigation, and cannot accommodate Respondents' proposed hearing dates. Accordingly, Motion No. 781-50 is denied.


