
**ORDER No. 39: MINUTE ORDER DENYING TRICO'S MOTION FOR
SANCTIONS**

(July 20, 2015)

On July 9, 2015, Respondents Trico Products Corporation and Trico Componentes SA de CV (collectively, "Trico") filed a motion for sanctions against Complainants Valeo North America, Inc. and Delmex de Juarez S. de R.L. de C.V. (collectively, "Valeo"). (Motion Docket No. 928-047.) On July 15, 2015, Valeo filed a response opposing Trico's motion.

On July 17, 2015, I held a pre-hearing conference in this investigation and addressed the merits of Trico's motion for sanctions. For the reasons stated on the record, Trico's motion for sanctions is DENIED. (See Pre-Hearing Conference Transcript, EDIS Document No. 561094.)
