**ORDER NO. 4: INITIAL DETERMINATION SETTING AN 18-MONTH TARGET
DATE**


(October 18, 2018)

Pursuant to Commission Rule 210.51(a), a target date for completion of the Investigation in the above-captioned matter must be set. The Notice of Investigation was published on October 2, 2018. 83 Fed. Reg. 49,575-576. Complainant proposes a 15-month target date. Respondents request that the target date be set at 18 months due to the volume of potential third-party discovery.

In view of the undersigned's responsibilities in other investigations and given the number of Respondents and asserted claims, Complainant's proposed target date is not feasible. The undersigned currently has an initial determination due on September 20, 2019 in Inv. No. 337-TA-1123. Were a 15-month target date adopted, the initial determination in this Investigation would be due on September 2, 2019, leaving less than three weeks for the undersigned to draft the initial determination in the 1123 investigation. The undersigned has therefore determined it necessary to set an 18-month target date in this Investigation in order to afford him an adequate amount of time to draft the initial determination while attending to his other commitments, responsibilities in other investigations, as well as his administrative duties as Chief Administrative Law Judge.

Pursuant to 19 C.F.R. § 210.42(h), this Initial Determination shall become the determination of the Commission unless a party files a petition for review of the Initial Determination pursuant to 19 C.F.R. § 210.43(a), or the Commission, pursuant to 19 C.F.R. § 210.44, orders, on its own motion, a review of the Initial Determination or certain issues herein.
