ORDER NO. 4: DESIGNATING INVESTIGATION “MORE COMPLICATED”

(December 18, 2009)

Pursuant to Commission Rule 210.60, I hereby designate this investigation “more complicated.” *See also* 19 U.S.C. 1337(e)(2) (2009). The “more complicated” designation is being conferred on the basis of the complexity of the issues raised in the motion for temporary relief. Specifically, the motion for temporary relief involves, *inter alia*: (1) two patents which relate to microelectromechanical system (“MEMS”) microphone packaging; (2) multiple products accused of infringement; and (3) the likelihood of the assertion of multiple alleged invalidating prior art references.

Pursuant to Commission Rule 210.62, an evidentiary hearing on the motion for temporary relief shall commence on Wednesday, February 17, 2010, at 8:30 a.m. in Hearing Room A of the United States International Trade Commission, 500 E Street, S.W., Washington, D.C. 20436. The hearing is scheduled for three days. Counsel for all parties shall be in attendance.

Notice of this Order shall be published in the *Federal Register* pursuant to Commission

Rule 210.60.
