By publication of a notice in the *Federal Register* on October 27, 2014, pursuant to subsection (b) of section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, the Commission instituted this investigation to determine:

[W]hether there is a violation of subsection (a)(1)(B) of section 337 in the importation into the United States, the sale for importation, or the sale within the United States after importation of certain dental implants by reason of infringement of one or more of claims 1–5 and 19 of the '977 patent [U.S. Patent No. 8,714,977] and claims 15–19, 29, 30, and 32 of the '443 patent [U.S. Patent No. 8,764,443], and whether an industry in the United States exists as required by subsection (a)(2) of section 337.

79 Fed. Reg. 63940 (Oct. 27, 2014).

The complainants are Nobel Biocare Services AG of Kloten, Switzerland and Nobel Biocare USA, LLC of Yorba Linda, California. The named respondents are Neodent USA, Inc. of Andover, Massachusetts and JJGC Indústria e Comércio de Materiais Dentários S/A of Curitiba, Brazil. The Office of Unfair Import Investigations is also a party to this investigation.

Based upon the complaint, the notice of investigation, the parties' discovery statements and proposed procedural schedules, and the schedule of the administrative law judge, it is determined that the initial determination on violation shall be due on October 27, 2015, and that

the target date for completion of this investigation is February 29, 2016, which is 16 months after institution of the investigation.¹ See 19 C.F.R. §§ 210.42(a)(1)(i), 210.51(a).




