**ORDER NO. 6:      SETTING TARGET DATE**

(December 30, 2009)

On December 16, 2009, the Commission issued a Notice of Investigation in this matter to determine:

[W]hether there is a violation of subsection (a)(1)(B) of section 337 in the importation into the United States, the sale for importation, or the sale within the United States after importation of silicon microphone packages and products containing the same that infringe one or more of claim 1 of U.S. Patent No. 6,781,231 and claims 1, 2, 7, 15, 16, 17, 18, and 20 of U.S. Patent No. 7,242,089, and whether an industry in the United States exists as required by subsection (a)(2) of section 337.

(See Notice of Investigation.) The investigation was instituted upon publication of the Notice of Investigation in the *Federal Register* on December 22, 2009. See 74 Fed. Reg. 68077 (2009). 19 CFR § 210.10(b).

The complainant is Knowles Electronics LLC of Itasca, Illinois. The respondent is Analog Devices Inc. of Norwood, Massachusetts. The Commission Investigative Staff of the Office of Unfair Import Investigations is also a party in this investigation.

Based upon the complaint and notice of investigation, the Initial Determination on alleged violation of section 337 shall be due November 22, 2010,<sup>1</sup> and the target date for completion of this investigation is March 21, 2011, which is 15 months after institution of the investigation. *See* 19 CFR § 210.51(a); 19 CFR § 210.42(a)(1)(i).

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
