ORDER NO. 22: SETTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

(July 20, 2009)


On this same day, the ALJ issued an initial determination extending the target date to February 9, 2010, with the remand initial determination due on October 9, 2009. The Commission's Order directs the ALJ to make additional findings regarding infringement, validity and domestic industry that are consistent with the Commission's claim construction and permits the ALJ to reopen the record as he sees necessary. (*See* Order: Remand of Investigation) (July 8, 2009). Absent a showing of good cause, ALJ finds that the record need not be reopened and that the remand proceedings can proceed on the evidence already in the record. The parties shall, however, present additional briefing on the above three issues through initial and reply remand briefs on the remand issues in accordance with the schedule set forth below, on the basis of the factual record already presented in this investigation.

The briefing schedule for the remand is as follows:


