**ORDER NO. 42: INITIAL DETERMINATION MODIFYING TARGET DATE
PURSUANT TO COMMISSION RULE 210.51(a)**

(November 6, 2009)

Given the breadth of the hearing record and the complexity of the issues raised by the parties therein, the Administrative Law Judge has determined that there is good cause to extend the target date in order to provide time for meaningful consideration of the parties' positions. The target date is currently set for May 14, 2010, with the final initial determination due January 14, 2010. The Administrative Law Judge finds that a small extension of the target date is not likely to prejudice any of the parties or unduly delay resolution of the Investigation. Accordingly, the Investigation target date should be extended to June 21, 2010, with the final initial determination due on February 19, 2010,

Pursuant to 19 C.F.R. § 210.42(h), this Initial Determination shall become the determination of the Commission unless a party files a petition for review of the Initial Determination pursuant to 19 C.F.R. § 210.43(a), or the Commission, pursuant to 19 C.F.R. § 210.44, orders, on its own motion, a review of the Initial Determination or certain issues herein.


