
**ORDER NO. 13: GRANTING APPLICATION FOR RECOMMENDATION TO THE  
U.S. DISTRICT COURT REQUIRING DEPOSITION OF  
COMPLAINANT EMPLOYEE HARUNOBU SANO IN JAPAN**

(March 18, 2010)

On March 17, 2010, Respondents submitted an application seeking a recommendation to the District Court in Washington, D.C. that the deposition of an employee of Complainant Murata Manufacturing Co. Ltd., Mr. Harunobu Sano, be ordered to proceed in Osaka, Japan. (Motion Docket No. 692-011.) Respondents represented that Complainants and the Commission Investigative Staff do not oppose the motion. (*Id.* at 2.)

The Administrative Law Judge finds that Motion Docket No. 692-011 should be GRANTED. The recommendation of the Administrative Law Judge is attached below.

**Recommendation To The United States District Court For The District Of Columbia To  
Issue An Order/Commission For The Taking Of The Deposition Of Mr. Harunobu Sano In  
Japan**

On March 17, 2010, Respondents Samsung Electro-Mechanics Co., Ltd. and Samsung Electro-Mechanics America, Inc. (collectively, "Samsung") filed with the United States International Trade Commission an application for a recommendation to the District Court of the District of Columbia to issue an Order/Commission requiring the deposition of an employee of Complainant Murata Manufacturing Co. Ltd. ("Murata") in Japan. Samsung requests assistance in obtaining deposition testimony from Mr. Harunobu Sano relating to an investigation into certain ceramic capacitors and products containing same, Inv. No. 337-TA-692, such deposition to take place on or about April 1, 2010, through on or about April 2, 2010, at the Consulate General of the United States of America, Osaka-Kobe or another United States Embassy or consulate located in Japan. The Commission Investigative Staff and Murata do not oppose Samsung's application.

On January 4, 2010, the procedural schedule issued in this Investigation, directing that fact discovery be completed by May 5, 2010, with an evidentiary hearing scheduled for July 2010.

It is requested that the District Court grant Samsung's motion for an Order/Commission to

obtain Mr. Harunobu Sano's deposition in connection with discovery for the above-identified Investigation at the U.S. International Trade Commission.

It is recommended to the District Court that an Order/Commission of the scope requested by Samsung be granted.


