ORDER NO. 4: SETTING TARGET DATE

(July 29, 2010)

On July 21, 2010, the Commission issued a Notice of Investigation in this matter to determine:

[W]hether there is a violation of subsection (a)(1)(B) of section 337 in the importation into the United States, the sale for importation, or the sale within the United States after importation of certain semiconductor products made by advanced lithography techniques or products containing same that infringe one or more of claims 1, 6, and 7 of U.S. Patent No. 6,042,998, and whether an industry in the United States exists as required by subsection (a)(2) of section 337.


(See Notice of Investigation.) The investigation was instituted upon publication of the Notice of Investigation in the *Federal Register* on July 27, 2010. See 75 Fed. Reg. 44015 (2010). 19 CFR § 210.10(b).

The complainant is STC.UNM, 801 University Blvd., SE., Suite 101, Albuquerque, New Mexico, 87106. The respondents are Taiwan Semiconductor Manufacturing Company Limited, 8, Li-Hsin Rd. 6, Hsinchu Science Park, Hsinchu, Taiwan 300-77; and Samsung Electronics Company Limited, 250, Taepyongro 2-ga, Jung-gu, Seoul 100-742, South Korea. The

Commission Investigative Staff of the Office of Unfair Import Investigations is also a party in this investigation.

Based upon the complaint and notice of investigation, the Initial Determination on alleged violation of section 337 shall be due July 26, 2011, and the target date for completion of this investigation is November 28, 2011¹, which is 16 months after institution of the investigation. *See* 19 CFR § 210.51(a); 19 CFR § 210.42(a)(1)(i).


