#### **Notice**

On this date, the administrative law judge issued the Final Initial Determination ("ID") on the question of violation of section 337. Further, the administrative law judge on this date also issued the Recommended Determination ("RD") concerning the remedy that may be appropriate in the event that the Commission ultimately finds a violation of section 337. Public versions of the ID and RD will be available within 30 days.

As explained in the ID, a violation of section 337 has been found. The ID contains, among other things, the following conclusions:

- 1. The Commission has subject matter, personal, and *in rem* jurisdiction in this investigation.
  - 2. The importation requirement is satisfied as to Maxlite, Satco, and Litetronics.
- 3. Maxlite's accused products infringe asserted claims 1, 2, and 11 of U.S. Patent No. 7,053,540 ("the '540 patent").
  - 4. Satco's accused products infringe asserted claims 1, 2, and 11 of the '540 patent.
- 5. Litetronics's accused products infringe asserted claims 1, 2, and 10 of the '540 patent.

- 6. The domestic industry requirement is satisfied as to the '540 patent.
- 7. It has not been shown by clear and convincing evidence that any asserted claim of the '540 patent is invalid.
