ORDER NO. 19:

DENYING MOTION TO TERMINATE THE INVESTIGATION AS TO RESPONDENT CHAMPION POWER EQUIPMENT, INC. BASED ON CONSENT ORDER STIPULATION AND PROPOSED CONSENT ORDER

(September 12, 2018)

On August 23, 2018, Respondent Champion Power Equipment, Inc. ("Champion") moved (1123-008) to terminate the Investigation as to Champion based on a Consent Order Stipulation and Proposed Consent Order. On September 4, 2018, Complainant Walbro, LLC ("Walbro") opposed the motion. The Commission Investigative Staff ("Staff") filed a response opposing the motion. On September 6, 2018, Champion filed amended versions of the Consent Order Stipulation and Proposed Consent Order to address Staff's concerns.

Champion notes that "[t]he Commission has authority to terminate an investigation as to Champion based upon Champion's Proposed Consent Order submitted herewith." (Mem. at 2 (citing 19 U.S.C. § 1337(c).) Champion asserts that the Consent Order Stipulation and Proposed Consent Order comply with the Commission Rules. (*Id.* at 4.) Champion also asserts that "[e]ntering the Proposed Consent Order and terminating the Investigation as to Champion would streamline the Investigation, avoid needless litigation, and conserve the resources of both the parties' and the Commission, thereby serving the public interest." (*Id.* at 3.)

Staff asserts that the Consent Order Stipulation "does not appear . . . at this time to comply with all of the requirements of Commission Rule 210.21(c)(3)." (Staff Resp. at 4.) Staff explains

that the Stipulation does not identify all of the claims asserted in the Investigation and instead omits claims 2 and 19 of U.S. Patent No. 6,394,424. (*Id.* at 4-5.) Staff further asserts that the Stipulation does not contain the required admission of all jurisdictional facts. (*Id.* at 6.)

Staff notes that the Proposed Consent Order is also out of compliance with the Rules. (*Id.* at 7-8.) Staff explains that the Proposed Order does not identify all of the asserted claims. (*Id.*) Staff asserts that the Proposed Consent Order "should identify carburetors in addition to products containing such carburetors." (*Id.* at 8.) Staff further argues that the Proposed Consent Order should specifically include a statement that Champion shall not sell for importation, import, or sell after importation the "Subject Articles" "except under consent, license from Walbro, *or to the extent permitted by a settlement between Walbro and Champion.*" (*Id.* (emphasis added).)

Walbro asserts that the Proposed Consent Order is "improperly restricted." (Opp. at 5.) Walbro explains that the Proposed Consent Order is "unnecessarily limited to the two products identified in the Complaint." (Id. at 6.) Walbro also asserts that the Proposed Consent Order "fails to even address the disposition of inventory currently awaiting sale in the United States." (Id. at 8.) Walbro explains that the Consent Order Stipulation identifies existing U.S. inventories of infringing products, but exempts them from the Consent Order. (Id.) According to Walbro, "Champion's Consent Order Stipulation makes it plain that Champion wants to sell or otherwise transfer inventory including within the United States." (Id.)

Champion's amended Consent Order Stipulation and Proposed Consent Order appear to adequately address Staff's concerns. The undersigned agrees with Walbro, however, that granting the motion to terminate based on the Consent Order Stipulation and Proposed Consent Order would not resolve all issues regarding inventory. Walbro seeks cease and desist orders against the Respondents, including Champion. 83 Fed. Reg. 21,140, 21,160 (May 8, 2018). The Consent Order

Stipulation would allow Champion to dispose of its inventory in the United States by selling it. Such an action is inconsistent with Walbro's requested relief. Accordingly, granting the motion to terminate will not afford Walbro all of the relief to which it would otherwise be entitled. See Certain Starter Motors & Alternators, Inv. No. 337-TA-755, Order No. 11, at 2 (Mar. 22, 2011).

For the above stated reasons, Champion's motion (1123-008) is hereby denied.
