ORDER NO. 4: INITIAL DETERMINATION SETTING TARGET DATE AT SEVENTEEN MONTHS

(November 13, 2017)

By publication of a notice in the *Federal Register* on October 11, 2017, pursuant to subsection (b) of section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, the Commission instituted this investigation to determine:

Pursuant to subsection (b) of section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, an investigation be instituted to determine whether there is a violation of subsection (a)(1)(B) of section 337 in the importation into the United States, the sale for importation, or the sale within the United States after importation of certain thermoplastic-encapsulated electric motors, components thereof, and products and vehicles containing same by reason of infringement of one or more of claims 1, 2, and 4-7 of the '200 patent [U.S. Patent No. 7,154,200]; claims 24-27 of the '348 patent [U.S. Patent No. 7,928,348]; claims 1, 2, 14, and 15 of the '509 patent [U.S. Patent No. 7,683,509]; claims 3, 9, and 11 of the '944 patent [U.S. Patent No. 7,067,944]; and claims 10 and 12 of the '952 patent [U.S. Patent No. 7,067,952]; and whether an industry in the United States exists and/or is in the process of being established as required by subsection (a)(2) of section 337.

Additionally, pursuant to Commission Rule 210.50(b)(1), the Commission ordered:

Pursuant to Commission Rule 210.50(b)(1), 19 CFR 210.50(b)(1), the presiding Administrative Law Judge shall take evidence or other information and hear arguments from the parties or other interested

persons with respect to the public interest in this investigation, as appropriate, and provide the Commission with findings of fact and a recommended determination on this issue, which shall be limited to the statutory public interest factors set forth in 19 U.S.C. 1337(d)(1), (f)(1), (g)(1).

In view of the other investigations currently assigned to me, and the breadth of the issues raised in this investigation, I find that I cannot accommodate this investigation with a 16-month target date. Therefore, I hereby determine that the target date for this investigation shall be Monday, March 11, 2019, which is seventeen (17) months from the date the notice of investigation was published in the Federal Register. *See* 19 C.F.R. § 210.51(a). Consequently, any final initial determination would be due by Monday, November 12, 2018. *See* 19 C.F.R. § 201.14(a); 19 C.F.R. § 210.42(a)(1)(i).

Pursuant to 19 C.F.R.§ 210.42(h), this initial determination shall become the determination of the Commission unless a party files a petition for review of the initial determination pursuant to 19 C.F.R. § 210.43(a), or the Commission, pursuant to 19 C.F.R. § 210.44, orders on its own motion a review of the initial determination or certain issues herein. **SO ORDERED.**
