**ORDER NO. 8: GRANTING COMPLAINANT SLING MEDIA, INC'S MOTION TO
STAY THE PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE UNTIL SUCH TIME
THAT ANY RESPONDENT AFFIRMATIVELY AND/OR
ACTIVELY PARTICIPATES IN THE INVESTIGATION**

(July 10, 2013)

On June 14, 2013, complainant Sling Media, Inc. ("Sling Media") filed a motion to stay the Procedural Schedule until such time that any Respondent affirmatively and/or actively participates in this Investigation. (Motion Docket No. 878-004.) No responses were received.

Sling Media argues that a stay of the Procedural Schedule until a Respondent affirmatively and/or actively participates in this Investigation would preserve judicial resources and those of Sling Media and cause no prejudice to any party to this Investigation.

Respondents Monsoon Multimedia, Inc. ("Monsoon") and C2 Microsystems ("C2") have not responded to the Complaint and Notice of Investigation. Counsel for Monsoon entered an appearance in this Investigation, but with the exception of filing a Motion to Terminate Based on Entry of Consent Order (Motion Docket No. 878-005) Monsoon has not actively participated in this Investigation. Neither Monsoon nor C2 have participated in discovery. (Mot. Mem. at 5.) Monsoon did not respond to this motion or my Order to Show Cause (Order No. 5.).

Respondent Belkin was terminated from this Investigation on July 5, 2013. (Comm'n Notice (July 5, 2013).) I found Monsoon in default on July 8, 2013. (Order. No. 7.) On June 28,

2013, Sling Media filed a Motion for an Order to Show Cause and for Default Judgment Against C2. C2 has not responded to said motion to date.

Accordingly and there being no opposition, Sling Media's motion (878-004) is hereby GRANTED. The Procedural Schedule in this Investigation is stayed until such time that a Respondent actively participates in the Investigation.
